

Romania government does not incorporate tunnels for protected amphibians and reptiles in environmental planning

I wish to complain that a survey of environmental consultants revealed that Romania government does not incorporate tunnels for protected amphibians and reptiles in environmental planning because they say that they do not have there are no clear information guides and manuals approved by the ministry. But the ministry does not see this as a problem. There are 650km of motorway and 2200 km of express roads (4 lane roads) that will be constructed in Romania before 2030. Several road projects were stopped and ended up in court in the past 3 years because of the lack for adequate environmental planning.

Please can you ensure that ignoring EPS in road projects does not continue in this regards and for other small EPS impacted by roads (e.g. some light-sensitive bats).
